THE INSTITUTION

The Agrupamento de Escolas Emídio Navarro (AEEN), created in April 2013, resulted from the aggregation of Emídio Navarro Secondary School with Schools Group D. António da Costa. It is located in Almada, a city that is located in the Metropolitan Area of Lisbon, on the south bank of the Tagus river. The Emídio Navarro, D. António da Costa schools are formed as the oldest public schools in Almada, having been created in 1956 and, respectively, in 1959.

The AEEN recently created, encompasses seven schools covering all levels of education, from kindergarten to secondary level (12th grade), with 3000 students and 300 teachers.

- High School Emídio Navarro (ESEN), with the 3rd cycle of basic education, regular secondary education, professional courses and courses of education and training of adults.
- School 2.3 D. António da Costa (EDAC), with the 2nd and 3rd cycles of basic education.
- Schools and EB1 Almada paragraph 3 of Cova da Piedade, with the basic education cycle.
- Schools EB1/JI Cataventos da Paz, EB1/JI Cova da Piedade and EB1/JI # 3 of Almada, with the 1st cycle of basic education is well developed and where pre-school education in kindergartens for children that integrate these three schools.

3RD GENERAL LYCEUM OF ILIOUPOLIS, ATHENS, GREECE

THE INSTITUTION

The 3rd General Lyceum of Ilioupolis is located in Athens, Greece, in the south suburbs, only 20 minutes from Athens city center. It is located at the end of an urban area, at the bottom of Ymittos mountain, next to a pine park to the north and a view over to the Aegean sea to the west (Laskaratou & Olympioniko 2, Ilioupolis-Athens 163-42 Greece).

It is a school with about 30 teachers and 340 students aged 15-18. It incorporates two buildings connected to each other. It has several rooms for teaching using multi-media, science laboratories, halls of Informatics and Design. It also features large outdoor areas in which the students relax during breaks. Or they are active and practice sports in the outdoor basketball and volleyball courts. The Theatre Hall is appropriately equipped for making all kinds of events, such as speeches, lectures, theatrical and musical events, school celebrations and graduations. It has an organized library, used by students and teachers for the conduct of some project courses and presentation. During the year, in parallel with the educational program, students can organize art competition, on painting, photography, original music composition, literature and dramatic art, in which they declare participation according to their artistic skills.

The students' main goal is to end their basic and advanced studies in the last three years of Secondary education and take the National Admission exams to enter the University in most academic fields of Sciences, Medicine, Economics, Technology, Military and Sports Academies.

Our students also participate in European programmes, such as, Some of the most recent ones, International: Erasmus+ KA101(2014-16), Erasmus+KA201 (2017-2020), Euroscola, PISA, eTwinning (2014-2019) and Student exchange with Roskilde-Denmark. In National competitions (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Youth Film Festival(2016-17), but also in the Pan-Hellenic school championships (volleyball, basketball, football with some success).

It was born in 2007, as result of the collaboration among teachers and trainers interested in the Media Education issues and the researchers working in the Communication Department, the Psychology Department of the University of Pavia, public bodies involved in the EMECE European project (Eduquer aux Médias pour un Espace Civique Européen- Projet Comenius 2.1 N. 226642-CP-1-FR-C2.1). CEM's associates are teachers, psychologists, sociologists, experts of communication (video maker), languages learning/teaching, experts of web and software editing, university's professors and researchers. They are all interested in multimedia communication, language learning and teaching to adults and development of the ICT.

CEM organizes:

University of Oradea is a creative, energetic, active and innovative university. Teachers, professors and researchers are very enthusiastic and determined to experience all the new opportunities offered by informational technology. At the end of the 18th century, "a higher institution for philosophic teaching" is founded in Oradea in 1780, which was to become in 1788 the Faculty of Law, the oldest faculty not only within the Romanian borders but also in a vast region of Eastern Europe. Today, the University of Oradea is an integrated institution of higher education of this kind, comprising 15 faculties, where around 10,000 students are being educated.

Our Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities exists since 2002. Meanwhile, we have continuously expanded our educational offer to the point where now we are offering, through our three Departments (Psychology, Educational Sciences and Social-Work – Sociology) 6 Bachelor Degree programs: Social Work, Human Resources, Sociology, Psychology, Primary and Preschool Teacher Training (both in Romanian and Hungarian) and Special Needs Teacher Training. Every year, around 500 students start as freshmen in the programs mentioned above and enjoy the facilities provided by our Faculty. Along with them, some 200 of our graduates (or other Faculties' graduates) choose to continue their studies at a Master's level while between 30 and 50 candidates enlist in the Ph.D. Program of Sociology.

At this moment, our staff consists of 49 teachers on tenure, while some other 40 teachers collaborate parttime with us. We are proud to have one of the lowest average ages in our University (the average age of our staff is under 40 years).



ORADEA, ROMANIA

Oradea [o'radea] is the capital city of Bihor County and Crişana region and one of the most important economic, social and cultural centers in the western part of Romania. Located about 10 km from Borş, one of the most important crossing points on Romania's border with Hungary, Oradea ranks tenth in size among Romanian cities.

Oradea enjoys a high standard of living relative to other Romanian cities and ranks among the most livable cities in the country. The city is also a strong industrial center in the region, hosting some of Romania's largest companies. Besides its status as an economic hub, Oradea boasts a rich Art Nouveau architectural heritage and is a member of the Réseau Art Nouveau Network.

LUV takes an active part in regional community by improving the educational structure of the population, by motivating and informing the members of the community and by involving them in the formal and non-formal educational programmes. Staff of 15 is supported by over 60 contractual teachers.

Programmes are intended for adults and youngsters. Programmes include: primary school for adults, programmes for vocational secondary education, professional secondary education, technical-vocational education, professional post-secondary education, language courses and ICT courses for adults and teenagers, training programmes for special labour requirements, study courses, leisure programmes, the national and international projects, etc. Within LUV also operates Centre for Intergeneration learning that includes 2 permanently employed mentors and over 20 volunteers and Pattern City – an ecosystem for education, experimentation, prototyping and innovation. Unique, interactive digital learning environment is focused on providing interdisciplinary content with learning by doing and playful learning methodologies.

Recently we open the Center for Intercultural Dialogue Velenje, in which we are counselling the migrants, newcomers and persons with international protection. We also offer a variety of free workshops for learning Slovenian language, learning about the environment and exchanging information about other cultures and customs. LUV is actively involved in various local, regional and national initiatives and actions (Life-long learning week, educational festivals and other events). LUV has years of experience in participating and coordinating European projects and is currently involved in 14 Erasmus+ projects.
